- 9. Eight (8) contestants will be selected from draw drum at each draw time (SEE DRAW TIMES)
 - a. Contestants will be announced at Guest Services.
 - (i) Contestants must be eligible to win. (See GENERAL RULES FOR ELIGIBILITY)
 - i. If contestant is not eligible then ballot will be void and a new contestant will be drawn from the draw drum.
 - (ii) Contestants will have four (4) minutes to present themselves to Guest Services.

10. Contestants will be brought to the Stage Bar to play a Family Feud style game.
 - a. Representatives of the team of contestants are posed questions that have already been answered by a survey of 100 people although, sometimes, the surveyed audience would be further narrowed down (e.g. "100 women"). An answer is considered correct if it is one of the concealed answers on the game board, or judged to be equivalent. Each answer has a point value assigned to it, depending on how many of the people surveyed gave that answer.  - b. Four (4) Rounds will be played.
 - (i) Round 1 – Straight Points
 - (ii) Round 2 – Straight Points
 - (iii) Round 3 – Double Points
 - (iv) Round 4 – Triple Points
 - c. Each question starts with a team member from each team who face off at the face-off podium to see who will gain control of that particular question. Whoever guesses the more popular answer in the survey decides if they want to play or pass off to the other team. Players are automatically given control if they guess the "Number one answer," the answer most commonly given.
 - d. The next team member in line will be able to guess an answer to the question. Team members may not confer with one another while in control of the board. The team gets a strike if a player gives an answer that is not on the board or fails to respond.
 - (i) Team members have a brief moment to give their answer. If there is no answer after the brief moment, they will be buzzed and get a strike.
 - (ii) Three strikes cause the team to relinquish control of the board, giving the other team a chance to steal the points in the bank by correctly guessing just one of the remaining answers.
 - e. The opposing team that is given the opportunity to steal the points with one answer can then confer with each other for up to 15- 20 seconds before an answer is given.
 - (i) The team captain can then either select one of the answers given by the team or give his or her own. If the team guesses a remaining answer, they will receive the points accumulated by the other team. If their answer is not on the board, the points are awarded back to the 1st team.
 - f. After the round is completed, the next two members of each team will face-off at the face-off podium and repeat everything again with a new question.
 - g. At the end of the four rounds, points will be accumulated and winner will be announced.
